
On 1/22/07, appellant filed an application for full reasonable attorney's fees. Appellee opposed the motion on 2/9/07. The court determined that the motion should be held in abeyance pending its decision in *State v. Native Village of Nunapitchuk*, Case No. S-11525. On 4/30/07, the court issued that opinion.

The court requests supplemental briefing on the effect of *Nunapitchuk* on the pending attorney's fees motion in this case, including whether appellant's counsel should be required to apportion his fees, as well as an accounting of the portion of full fees that is attributable to the successful constitutional claims.

Appellant may have until 6/1/07 to file a supplemental memorandum. The State will have seven days to respond under Appellate Rule 503(d).
