



Vermont State Hospital Served During First Quarter CY2008

Antipsychotics include drugs with typical or atypical antipsychotic therapeutic class (H2G,H7O,H7R,H7S,H7T,H7U,H7X). Antidepressants include drugs with an antidepressant therapeutic class (H2U,H2X,H7B), or a SSRIS, SNRIS, NDRIS, or SARIS therapeutic drug class (H2S,H7C,H7D,H7E).
