

#### **Coercion Impedes Alternatives**

- · Path of Lease Resistance.
- Effective Representation Changes Balance
  - No Longer Path of Least Resistance
  - Less Than 10% of Involuntary Commitments Meet Legal Standard
  - Forced Drugging/Electroshock Can Never Meet Legal Standard
  - Least Restrictive/Intrusive Alternative Requirement


